Learning Corner

Badgers: In maths, Y5 and Y6 have continued to work on 'Measure'. To begin with, they found the volume of a range of shapes, including the use of a formula to find the volume of a cube or cuboid. After that, they continued looking at how to convert between common imperial and metric units of measure.

In Science, we investigated some different causes of environmental change and the impact these changes can have on both plant and animal life. We have also been finding out about rivers flooding and have begun to write newspaper reports about floods.

Foxes: This week in Foxes we have new arrivals! A tank full of tadpoles have kept the children mesmerised.

In English, we have been reading the Owl and the Pussy Cat. The children have been learning to recite the poem by heart and have created a dictionary of old words found in the poem.

In maths, year 3 have been recapping adding and subtracting fractions, while year 2 have continued to practise SATs papers and adding two 2 digit numbers.

Otters: We began the week listening to the story of "George and the Dragon" by Chris Wormell and writing punctuated sentences to match the pictures. Later in the week we investigated adding "ing" to root words e.g. fly changes to flying.

In phonics, we have been reading and spelling words containing the sound "oa" eg boat, throw, bone.

In maths, we have practised our number bonds to 10, some of us know them by heart.

In RE, topic we read "Bilal and the Butterfly".
